Programs

Master's Program

- Runs the curriculum including fundamental courses in public policy, political science, economics, cultural studies, and historical analysis that provide basic theoretical knowledge for science and technology policy.
- Requires students to write a master's thesis within 2 years.
- Guides graduates in continuing their academic training in a doctoral program or in pursuing professional careers in government, international organizations, NGOs, companies, or journalism.
- General scholarship recipients must have a minimum of 2 years of professional experience in a field with close relation to science and technology or relevant policy areas.(Mid Career Master's Program)

Doctoral Program

- Accepts students with a master's degree in policy-related fields, including political science, economics, sociology, journalism, geography, anthropology, philosophy, history, and STS. We also welcome PhDs, MDs, and JDs who wish to pursue a second doctoral degree at STP.
- Requires students to complete a doctoral dissertation within 4 years, depending on the number of courses that can be waived from the previous education.
- Prepares students for academic careers in teaching and research or for high-level positions of policy-making and policy-analysis in government, international organizations, NGOs, companies, and journalism.
- General scholarship recipients must have a minimum of 3 years of professional experience in a field with close relation to science and technology or relevant policy areas.(Mid Career Doctoral Program-Part time) Part time students can change their status to full time after admitted based on the relevant requirements.
