2. Descriptions of Elective common courses

HS585 Principles and Application of Vision

This course introduces the principle of human vision related to formation, color and space perception from the point of view of information processing, and discusses the bio-engineering aspect for applying this principle in the composition of visual formative work. Furthermore, this course provides the psychological process of visual appreciation of sculpture works.

HS586 Introductory Korean for Foreigners I

This course aims to teach foreign students enrolled in KAIST to read, write, speak and listen Korean language in order to develop the basic capability of communication in Korean, an essential elements for foreign students. In addition, the Korean culture is taught for better understanding of Korea.

HS587 Introductory Korean for Foreigners II

This course is available to foreign students who have completed Introductory Korean for Foreigners I or students who have equivalent Korean competency and is offered in spring semester. Students will work on advanced speaking, listening, reading and writing, and learn more practical Korean language and finish the basic grammar.
