Course Requirements

■ Master program

- A. Graduation Credits: at least 33 credits
- B. Mandatory General Courses: 3 credits and 1AU
 - CC010 Leadership seminar (Credit is not granted, but it is a required course, except for part-time and foreign students).
 - CC020 Ethics and Safety I (1AU)
- C. Mandatory Major Courses: Credits required from the department.
- D. Elective Courses: at least 18 credits (including mandatory Courses)
- E. Research: Maximum 12 credits (Including seminar credits, It can be substituted with research credit earned at students' department).
- F. Others: Take at least 6 credits of mandatory and elective major courses offered from other departments.

□ Doctoral program

- A. Graduation Credits: at least 60 credits.
- B. Mandatory General Courses: 3 credits and 1AU (not required, if you have already taken this in the master's program).
- C. Mandatory Major Courses: Credits required from the department.
- D. Elective Courses: 27 credits (including mandatory Course, 9 research credits for chemistry majors).
- E. Research: over 30 credits (Including seminar credits, Research course offered by the department, Chemistry majors must earn 39 research credits or more).
- F. Others: ① Credits earned in the master's program are accumulated in the doctoral program. (Except for research credits).
 - 2 Take at least 6 credits in mandatory and elective major courses from other departments.
