

Major Course Requirements for IP Minor Program

(For undergraduate students admitted in 2015 or before)

Please check the common graduation requirements.

■ Credit Requirement for Graduation: Required to complete a total of more than 18 credits

- Completion of at least 18 credits of majors including Mandatory Courses 6 credits

- In the event that an IP minor course and major/other minor/Humanities & Social Sciences courses overlap, up to 9 credits can be applied to both courses of study.

□ Transitional measures

- This course requirements are applied to the IP Minor students registered in spring 2014 semester and thereafter. To the students who registered with the IP Minor Program before 2013 Fall semester, original course requirements (3 credits from required major courses and 15 from elective major courses) are applied.

- IP301 IP Overview is counted as the repeating course for SS261 IP Overview. In case of repeating only, IP301 IP Overview is also counted as a Humanities elective major (Social Science).

- To the students who registered with the IP Minor Program before 2013 Fall semester, IP301 (Intellectual Property Overview) or IP406 (Understanding Intellectual Property) are applied for Mandatory Courses
