**Thesis Master's Degree Program**

- **Credit Requirement for Graduation: Required to complete total or more of 33 Credit**
- **Mandatory General Courses: 3 credits and 1AU**
  - CC010 Special Lecture on Leadership(Mandatory)
  - CC020 Ethics and Safety I (1AU)
- **Mandatory Major Courses: degree requirement**
- **Elective Courses: At least 18 Credits**
  - It is required to finish elective courses with at least 18 credits (including major mandatory courses)
- **Research Courses: At least 12 Credits**
  - At least 12 credits including Seminar courses
- **기타: At least 6 Credits**
  - It is required, at least, to take 6 credits from the courses from different department.

**Transitional measures**

These requirement only apply to those who enrolled since 2015. However, for those who enrolled before (~2014) need to comply to either former or current requirement.

(For Doctoral Program)**

■ **Credit Requirement for graduation: Required to complete total or more of 60 Credit**

■ **Mandatory General Courses: 3 credits and 1AU**

- The courses earned in the Masters course work can be used towards the Doctoral degree

■ **Mandatory Major Courses: degree requirement**

■ **Elective Courses: At least 27 credits**

- It is required to finish elective courses with at least 27 credits (including major mandatory courses, and 9 research courses credit for Chemistry Major).

■ **Research Courses: At least 30 credits**

- It is required, at least, to take 30 credits of research courses (including seminar credit, and corresponding major research courses)
- For Chemistry Major, research courses credit requirement is at least 39.

■ **기타: At least 6 credits**

- It is required, at least, to take 6 credits from the courses from different department.
- The courses earned in the Masters course work can be used towards the Doctoral degree (except research credits).

□ **Transitional Measures**
