\* Elective: Elective courses comprise (i) General Technology Management, including organization management, innovative strategy, financial management, and other technology-centered courses that serve as the basis of technology management; (ii) Innovation & Entrepreneurship, courses designed to promote core knowledge and practical capability of technology innovation and entrepreneurship (startup); and (iii) Digital Transformation & Technology, which covers integrated technology management and technology that will become a key issue of the future based on digital transformation. In these courses, students at the Graduate School of Innovation and Technology Management will be educated as leaders with capabilities in both technology and management.
