## **Entrepreneurship Program Course Requirements**

**(For undergraduates who have enrolled in year 2020 and after)**

**Entrepreneurship Minor Degree: Required to acquire 18 credits or more**

- 18 credits or more from courses offered by K-School
- No separate requirement for mandatory courses

※ The courses above cannot be double counted for any other minor or major degree credits.

**Interim measures**

These requirements shall apply to students applying for the minor in the Spring semester of 2020 or later. However, those applying for the minor in 2019 or earlier may choose to be subject to the above requirements according to their wish.
