The KAIST College of Business Master's Program in Green Business and Policy (GBP) Program is a two-year, full-time course established to nurture entrepreneurial talents in the sustainable field and global green growth policy and strategic talents. GBP provide a specialized course for nurturing startups that develops the ability to analyze and suggest alternatives and enables students to commercialize startup ideas in the field of sustainability.

Also, depending on your field of interest and career development goals, you can choose and complete the fields of focus on sustainable business, sustainable finance, and sustainable development policy.

■ Recruitment students

- Around 20 people per year

■ Eligibility

- Those who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher at home and abroad.
- Persons recognized by the Minister of Education as having academic background equivalent to or higher than the above qualifications.

■ Classification of students and scholarship benefits

- KAIST Scholarship Student: Those who receiving part of educational expenses from KAIST.
- General Scholarship Students: Those who receiving educational expenses through the recommendation of affiliated institution or paying educational expenses at their own expense.

■ Course opening and recruitment period

- Recruitment: around April every year
- Admission: around September every year
