Major Course Requirements of the Graduate School of Digital Humanities & Computational Social Sciences (For Master's Program)

- Credit Requirement for Graduation: at least 33 credits in total
- Mandatory General Courses: 3 credits and 2 non-credit courses
 - O CC500 Scientific Writing (3 credits)
 - CC010 Special Lecture on Leadership (Non-credit; general scholarship students and international students are exempt)
 - CC020 Completion of Ethics and Safety (Non-credit but required for graduation)
- Mandatory Major Courses: 6 credits
- Elective Major Courses: 15 credits or more
 - O Designated elective courses: 6 credits or more
 - O Advanced elective courses: 3 credits or more
 - * Up to 6 credits can be recognized for courses taken in other academic units (limited to courses open to both graduate and undergraduate students, with a course code of 400 or above)
- **Research Courses:** 9 credits or more (including 3 seminar credits)
 - O 9 credits including thesis research courses and seminar courses
 - O 3 of the required research credits can be earned with an internship lasting 2 months or more
