Distinguished Curriculum

Cohort curriculum in the 1st year

- 1st year students are required to take the same mandatories.
- To enhance financial basics, students are required to take 15 credits from finance & accounting based mandatory courses.

Strengthened English education

- 1st year students are required to take business writing and business presentation courses in English to improve their English communication skills.
- All mandatory courses are offered in English.
